Finished size: 69 ½" x 70"

Make this amazing Lone Star quilt using Triangle Patchwork techniques. This quilt is made using strip piecing and it is all straight sewing with **no** y-seams or templates needed.

For the rainbow version you will need specific quantities of each colour, but you can also use a jelly roll to make this quilt pattern.

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

Strips are 2 1/2" x width of fabric

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А	0.2m or 2 strips	G	0.5m or 6 strips
В	0.3m or 3 strips	H	0.4m or 5 strips
С	0.4m or 4 strips	_	0.4m or 4 strips
D	0.4m or 5 strips	J	0.3m or 3 strips
E	0.5m or 6 strips	K	0.2m or 2 strips
F	0.6m or 7 strips	Alternatively you can use a jelly roll instead of fabrics A to K	
BACKGROUND	2.6m	WIDE BACKING	2m
BINDING	0.6m	BATTING (78" x 78" needed)	2m

Equipment required:

Basic cutting equipment - mat, cutter and a straight ruler.

Basic sewing equipment - machine, seam ripper, small scissors, thread.

Required ruler: 60 degree triangle ruler, eg CGRT12560 - this is the 12 inch version. If you have the 8" ruler you can use it instead.

Recommended ruler: CGRT30 half sixty ruler (makes cutting the setting triangles easier)

Backing, Batting, Binding etc will not be needed on the day of the class.

This colouring page will help you decide on the colour scheme for your quilt. Make a number of copies and try out different colourings.

in my rainbow example I have 11 fabrics in the star.
